

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF ROAD INSPECTION OF SATURDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2005**

The Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. for Annual Fall Road Inspection. In attendance were: Chair Chester S. Pogonowski, Vice Chair Jane B. Magne, Member Allen G. Masenheimer, Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley, Township Engineer Mario Canales, Road Departments members Stephen Kraiss and David James.

Penn Oak Trail was scheduled for work in 2006. Mr. Canales would prepare bid specifications for early 2006. He would arrange for core samples to be taken to determine the sub-base of the road and re-evaluate what type of work would be done.

Drainage at 175 Robin Road was reviewed. The Road Department would regrade the swale from 178 Robin Road to the location of the existing backup area. Work would be done as part of spring drainage projects. Ms. Bradley would contact the homeowner.

The Ridge Avenue Pond required dredging. Mr. Canales would investigate dredging procedures and approximate costs with a local contractor. This information would be brought back to the Board for further review.

The Board viewed drainage issues at the Anchor Run Farm, as well as a collapsing barn ramp. They also inspected the newly installed solar panel array.

The Board inspected the frame house at Chippewa Farm for rental potential.

There being no further business or comment, Road Inspection adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
