

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, JANUARY 12, 2004**

The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Chair Chester Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane Magne and Member Allen Masenheimer. Also in attendance were Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley, and Mario Canales, Herb Hale and Charles Doherty of Township Engineers Pickering, Corts and Summerson, Inc.

A lengthy discussion took place regarding the proposed Datesman Community Sewer System. It was agreed that a meeting would be set up between Pickering, Corts and Summerson, Inc., Gilmore and Associates and Yerkes Associates to discuss the benefits/problems with the community system design.

Mr. Elmer Kaucher requested relief from penalty and late charges in connection with his 2002 Real Estate Tax Bill.

Settlement for Trivellini Conservation Easement was scheduled for Friday, January 16, 2004.

Possible conditions to a use variance in connection with the Pastorek Zoning Hearing were discussed. The Application would be before the Wrightstown Zoning Hearing Board on Wednesday, January 14, 2004, at which time the Zoning Board would render a decision that might entail certain conditions.

The Board convened into Executive Session to discuss personnel issues and ongoing litigation.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne to adjourn at 7:45 p.m. All were in favor.
