

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, MARCH 14, 2005**

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Vice Chair Jane B. Magne. In attendance were Member/Treasurer Allen G. Masenheimer, Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley, and Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons.

Road Foreman Stephen Kraiss discussed the need for a Chipper to replace current equipment that no longer functioned.

Mr. Joseph Valentine of Del Val Soil discussed options for replacing three failing septic systems at the Anchor Run Farm.

Sprint/American Tower: Appearing to discuss the Sprint/American Tower Conditional Use were: Mr. Michael Gill and Mr. Ben Sanchez of the legal firm of Ballard Spahr; Mr. Clem Poole of Sprint; Mr. Bob Altenbach of Network Building and Consulting, LLC; and Mr. Mike Hennegan of American Tower. It was agreed that Sprint would have sufficient information to answer questions regarding the adequacy of the tower support structure and regarding providing service at the lowest possible height in time for a Public Hearing scheduled for March 21.

Hanson Aggregates Land Development Waiver Application: The Board discussed possible solutions to residents' concerns with noise and dust emanating from the Hanson/Better Materials Quarry.

The Board convened into Executive Session to discuss land acquisition issues.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne to adjourn at 8:00 p.m. All were in favor.
