

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, APRIL 12, 2004**

The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Chair Chester Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane Magne and Member Allen Masenheimer. Also in attendance was Eileen M. Bradley, Township Administrator.

The Board discussed submitted plans for the traffic light installation proposed for the intersection of Wrightstown and Durham Roads.

It was determined that the Township Administrator and Engineer would attend a DEP meeting for Toll/Hibbs Septic Planning Modules.

The Board reviewed new road inventory data.

Ms. Bradley presented information from the Conservation Reserve Program sponsored by the USDA Farm Service Agency. Mr. Bill Serwell proposed installing grass terraces to help eliminate erosion of the Wicen farm fields. The program would reimburse 90% of the cost. The Board agreed to pick up the additional 10%, with Mr. Serwell installing the terraces.

The Board discussed options for the adoption of the proposed UCC Ordinance.

The Board met with Mr. Frank Davis and Mr. Robert Lloyd of the Wrightstown Planning Commission to discuss general issues.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne to adjourn at 7:55 p.m. All were in favor.
