

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, MAY 8, 2006**

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane B. Magne and Member Robert S. Lloyd. Also in attendance were Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley and Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons.

The Board discussed the following minor issues: a proposed off-lot replacement septic system; the fire pond on Hunter's Wood Drive; the issuance of business cards to committee members; the purchase of anti-icing and de-icing equipment.

The Board reviewed the following proposals: full insurance coverage through Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Risk Management Association (PIRMA); newsletter writing and printing through the Government Group.

The Board discussed the following proposed ordinances: open space tax rate freeze; noise; fireworks.

The Board discussed the status of relocation to Chippewa Farm and the possibility of renting one of the residential units on the property.

The Board reviewed details of a letter in support of the Anchor Nursery Wrightstown Zoning Hearing Board Application in preparation for a hearing scheduled on May 10, 2006.

The Board met with the Elected Auditors to review the 2005 annual audit.

The Board convened into Executive Session to discuss land acquisition and litigation issues.

There being no further business or comment, Ms. Magne made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski to adjourn at 9:15 p.m. All were in favor.
