

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, JULY 11, 2005**

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane Magne and Member Allen Masenheimer. Also in attendance was Eileen M. Bradley, Township Administrator.

The meeting was taken on location on Wooley Run and Hallowell Road residents to discuss drainage issues.

Mr. Heath Dumack discussed access to a proposed subdivision on his property at 677 Durham Road.

The Board discussed road and drainage work on Cherry Lane and Penns Park Road.

The Board discussed the possible co-location of a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania public safety antenna on the American Tower pole on the Garner property at 860 Penns Park Road.

The Board discussed closing the Village Library for one week for renovation of the entrance and restroom facilities.

Winter Road Maintenance Contract: *Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski, to approve the PADOT Winter Road Maintenance Contract for the upcoming season for \$6,107.64, which reflected a 10% increase over last year. All were in favor.*

Ms. Bradley asked the Board to review the GASB 34 Inventory provided by Pickering, Corts and Summerson, Inc. for any errors or omissions.

The Board agreed that the proposed Accessory Contractor Amendment of the Joint Municipal Zoning Ordinance was ready to distribute to the Jointure.

The Board convened into Executive Session to discuss land acquisition issues.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne to adjourn at 8:15 p.m. All were in favor.
