

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF WEDNESDAY JULY 26, 2004**

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester Pogonowski. In attendance was Vice Chair Jane Magne. Also in attendance were Township Administrator Eileen Bradley and Township Solicitor Terry Clemons, Esquire. Member Allen Masenheimer was absent.

Paving contractor Dosch-King had requested an increase of \$6,409.00 to their paving contract for excess material used during patch work. It was agreed that further information from the contractor would be needed to come to a decision.

The proposed 2004-2005 PADOT Winter Maintenance Agreement offered a 3% increase over last year's contracted rate. Mr. Pogonowski made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne, to approve Resolution #907, authorizing execution of the contract. All were in favor.

The Board reviewed the status of outstanding items in the Reshetar/Park Avenue Major Subdivision.

The Township Administrator had received quotes for tree work at various township properties. She would continue to research the project.

The Township Administrator was instructed to contact DelVal Soil for consulting on septic issues at the Anchor Run Farm.

Quotes for signage designed for conserved open space acquisitions needed to be updated to reflect current pricing before consideration by the Board.

The Board convened into Executive Session to discuss litigation and land Acquisition issues.

There being no further business or comment, Ms. Magne made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski to adjourn at 6:55 p.m. All were in favor.
