

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2005**

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane Magne and Member Allen Masenheimer. Also in attendance was Eileen M. Bradley, Township Administrator.

The Board authorized execution of Library Renovation Project documents by the Township Administrator.

The Board discussed options for providing relief to victims resulting from Hurricane Katrina.

Mr. Phillip Berman of Jericho Valley Drive had asked for relief from penalty and interest charges on his 2005 County and Township Real Estate Tax bill. The Board unanimously agreed that Mr. Berman was not exempt from the charges.

The Board reviewed draft plans for renovations at the proposed municipal offices at Chippewa Farm. The Board directed the Township Administrator to have the Architect draft construction plans, sprinkler plans and front exterior elevations.

The Board discussed alternatives to the current recycling program, which would not be pursued at this time.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne to adjourn at 6:35 p.m. All were in favor.
