

WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2005

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane B. Magne and Member Allen G. Masenheimer. Also in attendance were Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley, Township Engineer Mario Canales, and Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons.

The Board discussed adjustments to the annual Road Improvement Program for the 2006 maintenance season.

The Board discussed strategies for acquisition of rights-of-way for the installation of a traffic light to be installed at the intersection of Durham Road and Wrightstown Road in conjunction with the Toll/Hibbs Subdivision.

The Board discussed maintenance issues relating to the Anchor Run Farm including erection of eight-foot deer fencing that would require a variance from the Zoning Ordinance.

The Township Administrator announced approval by the Pennsylvania Museum and Historic Commission for renovations to the front porch of the Village Library.

The Board began discussions related to the 2006 Preliminary Budget.

The Board convened into Executive Session to discuss land acquisition issues.

The Board discussed policy and history with Ms. Shaila Dani of the Bucks County *Courier Times*.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne to adjourn at 7:50 p.m. All were in favor.
