

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION OF MONDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2004**

The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Chair Chester Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane Magne and Member Allen Masenheimer. Also in attendance was Eileen M. Bradley, Township Administrator.

Ms. Jennifer West of the Bucks County Courier Times discussed Township history and issues.

Mr. Sam Irvin of Benjamin Lane expressed concern about sprinkler heads in his home that needed to be replaced. Ms. Bradley would investigate further.

The Board reiterated its position that a retiming of the traffic light system at the Five Points Intersection should be done at PADOT expense, as PADOT had created traffic congestion with a posted detour.

Ms. Bradley stated that she would attempt to arrange a trip for the Wrightstown Planning Commission to Delaware Valley College to tour the septic system installations there. She would continue to attempt to arrange a tour to a community with a drip irrigation system in place.

It had come to the Township's attention that the Farmhouse at the Anchor Run Farm may be eligible for inclusion in the National Registry of Historic Places. It was agreed to address this with the Wrightstown Historical Commission.

A preliminary discussion of Budget 2005 also took place.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Masenheimer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne to adjourn at 7:30 p.m. All were in favor.
