

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES OF MEETING OF NOVEMBER 27, 2006**

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley and Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons. Vice-Chair Jane B. Magne was absent.

Worker's Compensation Policy: Ms. Bradley discussed a possible switch from the current Worker's Compensation carrier, KMIT, to PIRMA. Additional information was requested.

Anchor Run Farm Septic System: The Board discussed options for a septic system at the Anchor Run Farm. Ms. Bradley would investigate pricing of parts and installation as separate contracts.

Signage on Penns Park Road: A resident on Penns Park Road had requested children at play signage along Penns Park Road. Ms. Bradley would issue a letter and request a step up in police enforcement. On a similar note, Ms. Bradley would request new speed limits for Pine Lane.

Real Estate Signage: The Board discussed placing violation stickers on real estate signs placed over weekends. Violation letters would be sent to developers and additional violation stickers would be ordered.

Eagle Scout Projects: Ms. Bradley had received a letter from an Eagle Scout candidate in search of a project related to Chippewa Farm. She would schedule a meeting with Mr. Wright.

Cat Committee and Donations: Ms. Bradley was in receipt of a donation check for feeding the feral cats at Chippewa Farm. Mr. Clemons would memorialize the agreement with the Bucks County SPCA.

Budget 2007: The Board discussed salaries and benefits for 2007, and possible road projects.

The Board then convened into Executive Session to discuss possible litigation issues.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Lloyd made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski, to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 p.m. All were in favor.
