

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION MEETING OF JUNE 11, 2007**

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice-Chair Jane B. Magne, Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons and Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley.

**Historical Commission:** The Board met with members of the Historical Commission to discuss policy.

**Dimmler Subdivision:** Mr. Edward Murphy, Esquire and Mr. Paul Dimmler met with the Board to discuss stormwater options for an approved subdivision on Mill Creek Road.

**Neeld Tract:** Mr. Murphy then presented with his clients Linda and Kyle Neeld

**Foodshed Alliance:** The board met with Mrs. Robin Hoy of the Bucks County Foodshed Alliance to discuss terms of a draft lease agreement for the farmhouse at Anchor Run Farm.

**Cherry Lane Bridge Restoration Project:** The Board discussed a possible change order to the Cherry Lane Bridge Restoration Project. Township Engineer Mario Canales was working with the contractor, Harry DePue Inc., on figures for paving a portion of Cherry Lane from the new bridge installation to Park Avenue.

*On a motion by Ms. Magne, seconded by Mr. Lloyd, the Board agreed to a change order to pave an additional portion of Cherry Lane from the new bridge installation to Park Avenue, not to exceed \$10,000.00. All were in favor.*

**Central Bucks Ambulance:** Mr. Clemons presented a sample contract for services for Central Bucks Ambulance Squad (CBA). Ms. Bradley would forward to CBA for execution.

The Board then convened into Executive Session to discuss land acquisition and litigation issues.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Lloyd made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne, to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m. All were in favor.
