

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF WORK SESSION MEETING OF JULY 9, 2007**

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was held Monday, July 9, 2007 at the Township Office, 2203 Second Street Pike, Wrightstown. The Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons and Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley. Vice Chair Jane B. Magne was absent.

Village Library Renovations: Mr. Ken Hone of the Village Library Board requested permission to make minor renovations to the Community Room to allow the installation of a movie screen, wiring and speakers. Costs for equipment and renovations would be paid from a grant. Permission was granted, with the proviso that the Township Administrator would review any contracts prior to award for compliance with the Township Code.

The Board briefly discussed the status of the proposed Chippewa Farm Land Use Plan. The Board also reviewed a draft proposal for accounting services.

The Board then convened into Executive Session to discuss litigation issues with Eureka Stone Quarry and Szarko v. Wrightstown Zoning Hearing Board Appeal.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Lloyd made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski, to adjourn the meeting at 5:50 p.m. All were in favor.
