

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES OF MEETING OF OCTOBER 22, 2007**

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski at the Township Building at 2203 Second Street Pike, Wrightstown. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane B. Magne, Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley and Township Solicitor Terry W. Clemons. Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd was absent.

**Bucks County Foodshed Alliance:** Ms. Robin Hoy appeared to discuss terms of a proposed lease agreement with the Foodshed Alliance for the farmhouse at Anchor Run Farm.

**Chippewa Land Use Options:** The Board reviewed plans for a proposed on-lot sewage facility using peat filtration.

**Pension Excess Interest:** The Board reviewed options for distribution of excess interest paid by the Police Pension Plan and the Non-Uniform Pension Plan. Action would be taken at a later meeting.

**Administrative Issues:** Administrative issues discussed included: signage on Wrightstown Road; a temporary flag pole at Chippewa Farm; a Boy Scout Honor Ceremony invitation; a sample reimbursement ordinance. The Board also executed Resolution #2007-085, the Pineville Tavern Land Development approval, which had been approved at the October 15 meeting.

**Budget 2008:** The Board reviewed a draft budget for 2008.

The Board then convened into Executive Session to discuss the proposed Council Rock School District/Wrightstown Township Stipulation amendment and a personnel issue.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Pogonowski made a motion, seconded by Ms. Magne, to adjourn the meeting at 6:45 p.m. All were in favor.
