

**WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF MEETING OF JANUARY 14, 2008
DRAFT**

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane B. Magne, Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Solicitor Terry Clemons, Zoning Officer Ted Middleman and Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley.

The Board discussed possible acceptance of public improvements for the Park Hill and Warner Meadows Subdivisions.

Mr. Middlemen discussed outstanding code issues.

Mr. Sam Willard and Mr. Glen Willard queried the Board on several conceptual plans for properties along Route 413.

Courtyards at Penns Crossing traffic Light: The Board discussed a potential traffic light at the intersection of Second Street Pike and Penns Park Road.

The Board declined an offer for Hough Associates to complete a recycling grant application on behalf of the Township. The application would be completed in-house.

The Board authorized proceeding with the purchase of a 1996 Ford Bronco Fire Marshal Vehicle from Towamencin Volunteer Fire Company for \$8,000.00.

Mr. David Dutko of Worthington Mill Road discussed the video recording setup with the Board and problems with Verizon FiOS broadcast.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Lloyd made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski, to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 p.m. All were in favor.
