

WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF MEETING OF MARCH 24, 2008

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Vice Chair Jane B. Magne, Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Solicitor Susan Piette, Zoning Officer Ted Middleman and Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley.

Dr. and Mrs. Joseph Conroy of Wrightstown Road and of Durham Road discussed sprinkler system options at the former Livingston property.

Tax Collector Greg Soto met with the Board to discuss policy for bill distribution.

Mr. Joseph Colombo of Estates Court inquired into the procedure for possibly turning over privately-owned Estates Court to Township ownership and responsibility.

Mr. Michael Hoy and Gareth Kear of the CSA Subcommittee discussed drainage issues at Anchor Run Farm. Ms. Bradley would investigate cost of materials for installation of additional stormwater management.

The Board reviewed a proposal for accessory agricultural sales (H-15 Use) for a property on Swamp Road. The Zoning Officer would issue a permit to the applicant.

It was agreed to make a donation of \$100.00 to Upper Makefield Township toward a scholarship fund in the name of former Upper Makefield Township secretary Victoria Haug. The late Mrs. Haug spent many years working for Upper Makefield Township and the Jointure.

The Board reviewed current insurance coverage, discussed finances and the agenda for Road Inspection, scheduled for April 5, 2008 at 7:30 a.m.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Lloyd made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski, to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 p.m. All were in favor.
