

WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF MEETING OF MARCH 24, 2008

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors conducted Annual Spring Road Inspection throughout Wrightstown Township on Saturday, April 5, 2008, commencing at 8:00 a.m. In attendance were Chair Chester S. Pogonowski, Vice Chair Jane B. Magne, Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley, Township Engineer Mario Canales and Road Foreman Stephen Kraiss.

The following roads and areas were inspected:

Estates Court - Should the Township consider taking over the road, collapsed crossover pipes and clogged pipes will have to be addressed. Core samples should be taken to determine depth of paving.

Brownsburg Road - When the Township is ready for full reclamation, new culverts and crossover pipes throughout should be inspected and added to the specifications if required. Mr. Canales was to put together pricing for digging out alligator sections and patching. Mr. Kraiss was to reinstall the swales to allow for proper drainage. Mr. Canales would also check the elevations of the three inlet boxes to possibly remove the hoods and lower the inlet structures.

Alexander's Court - When Alexander's Court is crack sealed, the curb line also needs to be addressed.

Penns Park Road - Mr. Canales would estimate the cost of contracting out work to be done to: re-establish proper swales along both sides of road from top of the hill to Swamp Road which may include piping and inlet boxes; mill out shoulders of the road deeply; repaving.

Oil and Chip Schedule - Mr. Canales was instructed to reevaluate the current Road Maintenance Schedule and recommend roads to be oil and chipped. Additionally, Mr. Canales was to provide an updated list of roads with last repairs listed.

Inspection adjourned at 10:05 a.m.
