

WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF MEETING OF FEBRUARY 11, 2008

The Wrightstown Township Board of Supervisors Work Session was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair Chester S. Pogonowski. In attendance were Member/Treasurer Robert S. Lloyd, Township Solicitor Terry Clemons and Township Administrator Eileen M. Bradley. Vice Chair Jane B. Magne was absent.

Anchor Run Farm Issues: The Board discussed drainage costs and lease issues for the Anchor Run Farm, as well as possible agricultural deer control permits for bow hunting on the property.

Foodshed Alliance: Ms. Bradley noted that the Bucks County Foodshed Alliance was interested in relocating their weekly Farmer's Market to Chippewa Farm. They were encouraged to submit a Conditional Use Application.

Chippewa Farm Land Use: Ms. Bradley was instructed to update and resubmit cost estimates to the Board for options for use of Chippewa Farm in preparation for an additional public discussion.

Finance Review: The Board requested additional research of financials in preparation for the March 3, 2008 Board Meeting.

There being no further business or comment, Mr. Lloyd made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pogonowski, to adjourn the meeting at 6:10 p.m. All were in favor.
