

## MINUTES WRIGHTSTOWN TOWNSHIP HISTORICAL COMMISSION

Monthly Meeting  
Thursday, June 2, 2022

The meeting was held in The Meeting Room at the township building on Thursday, June 2, 2022 at 1:05 p.m.

**In attendance:** Betty Davis, Mary Lee Johnson, Beverly Wilson, Karl Niederer, Jane Del Bianco, and Jane Magne, virtually.

Betty Davis, Commission Chairman, opened the meeting at 1:05 p.m. Beverly Wilson, Secretary, read The Minutes of the May 5, 2022 meeting, which were approved as read.

Jane DelBianco, Treasurer, read the **Treasurer's Report**. Supply Budget Balance \$1,000. Savings Account \$8, 133.74, beginning balance. Interest \$.65. Savings Account Ending Balance as of June 2, \$8,134.39.

**Old Business:** It was mentioned that Lucille Slack, daughter of artist Roy Nuse, died May 1, 2020. She was born in 1919. Lucille had a daughter, Ellen.

Regarding the May 15 Open House, 30 people attended, which was a very good response, considering the construction going on at the intersection. \$22.00 was collected. Betty set up a schedule of volunteers for the June 19 Open House. Jane and Karl at 1:00. Betty and Mary Lee at 3:00, as well as Jane DelBianco. On July 17, we plan for the same schedule. August 21 will have an adjustment: Karl will be at the late shift.

**New Business:** Karl proposed "family of small publications, " similar to "Adopt an Open House" in the Fall. Karl will work on a series of flyers about the township, e.g. Schoolhouse, Walking Purchase, (legal size exhibition-style). Robert Chase Palmer, known to us as Chase Palmer, author of "Post Cards of Bucks County, PA 2020" is doing a book about Wrightstown schools.. Karl showed us brochures Timelines. Very nice to pass out at the Schoolhouse. Betty suggested that at our July 7, 1:00 meeting, we think about possible brochures similar to Timeline.

Jane Magne discussed Renny Reynold's Hortulus Farm. Renny's property is preserved. Plants. Owner has Willard property - working out of it. Name on 413 - near to Carousel Village. "PLANT" ??? We discussed local properties, which are currently on the


