- C. Lingohocken Fire Company Report. Chair Pogonowski reviewed the December 2017 report. There were 19 calls for service, 46 man-hours for responses and 132 man-hours for work details, for a total of 179 man-hours of service to the community.
- **D.** Central Bucks Ambulance Report. The Board accepted the December 2017 reports.

## **MANAGER'S REPORT:**

- **A.** Bid Award for Road Projects. Manager Pantano reviewed the bids received with the Board. On a motion by Treasurer Lloyd, seconded by Chair Pogonowski, the Board voted unanimously to award the bidder, General Asphalt Paving Company of Philadelphia, the job in the amount of \$254,540.89.
- B. S & D Ventures Letter of Credit Release #1. S & D Ventures requested a release of \$233,026.50 from their letter of credit. The Township Engineer reviewed the request and recommended instead that \$186,390.80 be released, with \$618,157.91 remaining. On a motion by Chair Pogonowski, seconded by Treasurer Lloyd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the release recommended by the Engineer.
