

Approved Meeting Notes from our October 13 Meeting:

Call to Order at 7:31PM

- Update on MS4 — the engineer has discussed with and gotten approval from DEP for researching an alternative plan, they are working on it and it has not been presented yet. We will continue to monitor progress on alternatives and will reach out to the community to inform them when a revised plan is being presented to ensure public awareness and input. Scott and Robin have offered several times to be available to give input on the plan as it is being developed. The offer was acknowledged but there has been no request for our participation yet.
- RF-100 —(Statewide effort for municipalities to prepare for 100% electric power in the future) A draft resolution was being prepared by Robin for the EAC before Covid, using other local townships' resolutions as models. A number in Bucks have now passed Resolutions to be Ready for 100. She will update the draft to bring to one of our next meetings in the near future for discussion.
- We discussed the need to improve EAC and Twp communication to the community, especially to make sure people hear about things like the MS4 project on Anchor Run Farm. A newsletter was suggested and people said they are not read. It was agreed that we would give reports at the Board of Supervisor's meetings periodically, quarterly if possible.
